



## National Professional Qualification for Middle Leadership NPQML (Primary, Secondary and Special Education)

You should be a middle leader in a school with the responsibility of leading a team, for example:

- ◆ a key stage leader
- ◆ a curriculum area leader
- ◆ a pastoral services leader
- ◆ a subject leader
- ◆ a head of department
