Locally delivered NASENCO programmes in your region

The National Award for SEN Coordination (NASENCO) is a mandatory requirement for all SENCOs appointed new to the role and is an excellent opportunity for professional development for aspiring SENCOs.

The programme will provide the opportunity for participants to reflect upon and improve their practice whilst learning more about the coordination of special educational needs, policy and supporting the individual needs of children and young people.

Accredited by Bath Spa University (BSU), this programme is worth the first 60 credits towards a Master's (MA) degree.

There will be local groups running for spring 2021.

We urge interested candidates to begin the application process as soon as possible.

Duration of study and outline of programme

To complete the programme participants will be expected to:

- Attend 6 face-to-face day sessions delivered by BPN and SEN specialists to engage in learning, share good practice and practise key skills.
- Write two assignments that add up to 60 credits.
- Complete an e-portfolio for any learning outcomes not covered elsewhere.
- Invest time in personal study – reading, research and on-going reflection on practice.
- Liaise with their group and academic tutor.

To support successful completion we ask and encourage schools to provide appropriate release time in order to give participants the opportunity to:

- Carry out school based activities for research and development.
- Visit other schools or settings, where appropriate.

Costs

The 6 day programme costs **£1,980 +VAT.**
